"Internally I Was Freaking Out"

During each *Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue* seminar, mentors lead small groups of JFA volunteers through a series of role-playing activities to prepare them for conversations during a college campus outreach.

The JFA mentors can't prepare a person for every situation, and although we can help volunteers calm some of their nerves, there is still a point at which volunteers have to plow through their fear. Naomi Wickham mentioned in her reflection that although she was well-prepared by the seminar, she was still "internally freaking out" about starting conversations.
